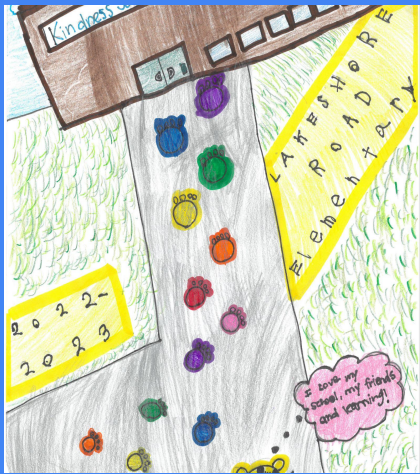
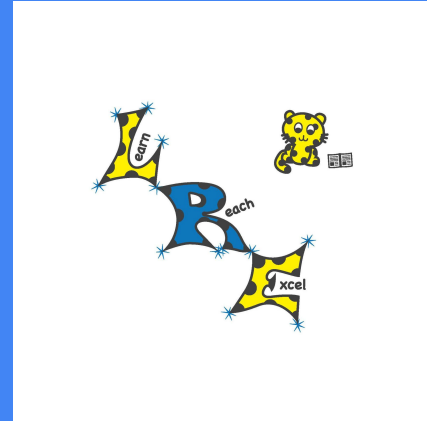

I will do my best to keep this short and simple:

- 4/11, 4/12 Grade 3 ELA testing
- 4/15, 4/16 Grade 4 ELA testing
- Make sure your child has an extra pair of clothing in their backpacks because the playground can be muddy this time of year.

FAQ about the State Tests

- **Will I get my child's scores?** Yes, score reports are sent home, often the fall of the next school year. You can see what areas your child did well in and opportunities for growth.
- **What does the school do with the information?** Teachers will get to see how their classes performed. Grade levels use the information to see where our strengths and opportunities for growth are as a building.
- **How long is the test?** There is no time limit on the test. The test consists of written passages that students answer multiple choice questions or respond in writing. Most students finish within an hour, but some take longer.

As we head into Spring Fever please remind your children of our rules to maintain a happy, safe school community:

1. **Be Responsible**
2. **Empathetic**
3. **Be Cooperative**
4. **Have a safe body**
5. **Be Helpful**

As always, your support is always appreciated! **Dismissal and arrival is always a busy time in the office.** If you plan to pick up your child at the end of the day please have your child bring a note in the morning. It is very difficult on the child, teacher and office staff to have a child ready on a whim. **PLEASE HELP EVERYONE OUT AND SEND A NOTE IF YOU HAVE A CHANGE IN PLANS.**

April Health Office Updates



School physicals are Tuesday, April 16th with a Board Certified Provider. You will receive notification if your child is scheduled for a School Physical Exam. Please complete and return an updated Health History and Food Allergy Form to be reviewed prior to the exam.



Please send spare clothing in the event your child jumps or falls in a mud puddle during recess. It can be very wet and muddy outside.



Our district will now be following the CDC COVID/Respiratory Illness Guidance:

- Symptoms of a respiratory virus include a fever, chills, fatigue, cough, runny nose, and headache. Please keep your child home if they have a fever, diarrhea, vomiting or if they would have difficulty participating in school activities.
- Students may return to school and normal activities when symptoms have improved and they have been free of fever, vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours, without fever-reducing medication.

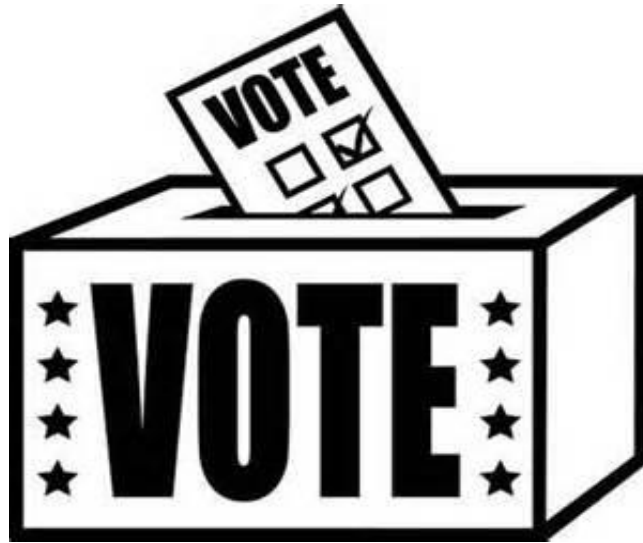
