

### June Band News from Mr. Bamonte


Congratulations on an excellent performance at the spring concert! I am very proud of all of you.

End of Year Medication Pick: All medications must be picked up by an adult. Please contact the Health Office to schedule a pick up time between Friday 6/21- Tuesday 6/25. Leftover medications will be discarded per district protocol.

Preparing for Next Year: Each school year, updated documentation is required for Medication Orders and/or Action Plans for students with a diagnosis of Allergies, Asthma, Seizures or Diabetes. Please connect with your child's provider to obtain these documents before the start of school. You may fax or email documents at any time and may drop medications off in late August.

Physical Exams: NYS requires all students entering K, 1st and 3rd grades to have an updated physical exam. Please send these documents as they are completed, by fax (315-218-2686) or e-mail at LRENurses@nscsd.org.

We are out of the office until late August. Please reach out to the Main Office with any urgent needs. We wish you a safe, adventurous and healthy summer and we'll see you next year!!




## By your side, for bicycle safety.

Check your bicycle for a good fit by standing over it. THERE SHOULD BE 1–2 INCHES BETWEEN YOUR BODY AND THE TOP BAR.



ALWAYS cross at a crosswalk and never between parked cars. BEFORE crossing:









## Check your helmet for the right fit.


Color in each scene to learn what a properly fitting helmet looks like.
